### Scholarship Recipients cont.

Carmen Vanegas is currently teaching Physics at Wellstone International High School in Minneapolis, housed at Roosevelt High School. Wellstone is a school for newcomer immigrant and refugee students aged 14-23, and all are English-language learners.

Because she did not have the knowledge and skills to effectively teach academic literacy to English learners, Carmen decided to complete an ESL licensure program through Hamline University. All of her course work is completed; what is left is student teaching which she hopes to complete this summer. With her newfound teaching methods, students are better able to reach the literacy skills that allow them to achieve a deeper understanding of content and to gain oral academic language proficiency. With her ESL licensure, Carmen will be allowed to teach ESL classes which will carry credits for students and be a paid position for her.


